To Whom It May Concern,

Jonathan Graber brought his horse Neal in to Texas Equine hospital presenting on 7/17/25 for swelling of the left front carpus for a few days' duration. A hard swelling with some fluid proximally was noted on the dorsal aspect of the left front carpus, range of motion was normal. A lameness exam was performed with Neal being sound on baseline and after flexion. Radiographs of the right front were also obtained, again with no significant findings. Advised putting DMSO/furacin/dex on the left front carpus twice a day till the swelling goes down or can-do steroid injections. Owner/ elected to do DMSO/furacin/dex.
